Dear sponsors, donors and friends of Living Hope High School,

We are very excited to tell you that the government will announce the plans for reopening the schools in the next few days. We hope to be in full swing soon. That will be such a blessing to the whole country! During the lockdown, we have been having secret school for 15 kids. They stayed to help the school keep running, take care of the crops and animals, help with maintenance and have classes for half the day. I had two teachers who volunteered and they have kept things moving. We also had 5 grads who came to teach too. The kids that are here will be far ahead of the kids who stayed home.

All of us here at Living Hope, would like to thank all sponsors, donor's friends for your continued and faithful support. A lot of our expenses have not gone down. We have paid teachers full salaries, paid their deductions, all the support staff have been working. We have spent a lot in maintenance, fencing and repairs. Because of your faithfulness and hard work of students and grads that have stayed, our school is in good shape. The government inspected our school last week, and said we were the best school and we are the most ready to be re-opened. Praise the Lord! We couldn't do it without you and God. We are waiting for the government announcement about re-opening. The government has given us a list of things we have got to do to qualify. We had to buy a thermo gun and test kits to test all the kids when they come back. Once we test them we have to pay for their treatment. We had to put in the extra hand washing stations and expand the nurse's hours.

UPDATE: School will be open next week on Monday, October 12, 2020. Nurse Catherine has been busy getting test for HIV and pregnancy for the students. New Thermo gun and hand washing stations and disinfectants are all ready to go. Desks and chairs have been repaired and varnished with locks installed on them. Rooms have been cleaned, walls scrubbed, windows cleaned and floors mopped. Carol and the cooks have inventoried the food, and cooks schedules are all worked out. Students who stayed at the school during the lockdown have taken their exams and will get their report cards soon. They have all done well and worked hard on the farm. Living Hope was a blessing to them by giving them a place to stay and food during lockdown. Praying that all the students who return come back healthy and well. Please continue to pray for the school and students. **Update** October 14, 2020, School did not open as planned due to the Government. Praying it will open soon! Form 4's will return to LHHS for two weeks and see how that goes.



When teams visited Living Hope many would spend days putting it on the books, it was a task but something that was needed. First we would like to thank Lavonne Hammett (US side) and Doricas Wegulo (Living Hope side) that work so hard to keep the finances and funds running smoothly. It is not an easy job! God Bless You Both!

Many people are wondering about their students and how sponsorship works. For each person, church or others that sponsors a Form 1, 2, 3 or 4 – (grades 9-12) student, monthly funds are sent into the school and they go into a pot per say for all the students attending Living Hope. Those who are sponsoring a student in those grades **must** send in their funds to Living Hope through Riverton UMC. You will receive a tax credit for the sponsorship. LaVonne, the treasurer then wires the funds to the school around the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month. Living Hope is audited yearly and when the GBGM (General Board of Global Ministries) came, they said the books were in great shape. The thanks goes to those who work so hard to keep it that way and those of you who donate to keep the school running so well. Those Funds go for many things which include:

For sponsors who want to send their student additional funds for something special, like shoes, flashlight, whatever, you can send that to them by earmarking it when you send in the funds to Riverton UMC. That money will go into a line item for the student. It will be separate from the tuition funds you send in Monthly. Doricas at Living Hope will put it into their account.

For those who sponsor a **College Student** you can send in your funds to Living Hope, via Riverton UMC to get a tax credit. If you do not need a tax credit then you can send it directly to your student using a money transfer. You would have to contact your student to see if they have a bank account to do this. Make sure your student is committed and responsible to keep track of what and how he/she spends the funds. They should be willing to send you a report of what they use the funds for and their grades. Many of the students use the Diamond Bank. There are many ways to do this, Pay Pal, Western Union and I personally use www.remitly.com


