## **Sponsored Student Update**


Because of the added students, Living Hope needs to get the students sponsored **ASAP**. We so appreciate everyone for their sponsorship and donations thus far, but with extra students, comes extra costs. If your church is not supporting anything in Missions we ask that you might consider to take on a student in Form one or another student that needs help in another form. It is a monthly gift of \$110 and some extra for the student's personal needs. At this time the school cannot pay for them. The extra \$5-10 a month will go towards personal needs, such as toothpaste, and tooth brush, soap, notebooks, pens, sanitary napkins for girls, haircuts and some pocket money for snacks and phone calls to their families. This is a gift beyond your \$110.00 sponsorship Cost.
