It will have an examination room and several convalescent rooms, running water, showers, a kitchen, heat of some sort, a garage that opens into the dispensary, a large meeting room in the middle and on the other side housing for 12 male and female guests (usually the mission team). We expect this to be a beautiful addition to the campus. It will be wired for heavy appliances and will have its own latrines and gray water treatment.
